### ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for selection by an NPC, athletes must have achieved one (1) of the following Minimum Qualification Standards (MQS) for their respective sport class between 1 January 2007 and 6 July 2008.

## MAXIMUM ENTRY PER NPC

An NPC can enter a maximum of three (3) qualified athletes per individual event.

An NPC can enter a maximum of one (1) qualified team comprising of three (3) qualified athletes per team event. (Athletes for the team event are selected from those who have competed in the individual events.)

#### DATES / PROCESS OF CONFIRMATION OF QUALIFICATION SLOTS

By 4 April 2008, each NPC must confirm to IPC Archery in writing (fax and e-mail are accepted) the number of qualification slots they will use. NPCs that have not replied by this date will have lost their qualification slots, and IPC Archery may reallocate these slots.

By 25 April 2008, IPC Archery will confirm in writing the reallocation of all unused qualification slots.

By 26 April 2008, it is officially declared that the respective NPC's will use the allocated quota granted for the Beijing 2008 Paralympic Games. Any NPC that does not use some or all of the qualification slots allocated may be subject to sanctions by the IPC.

# REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION SLOTS Slots allocated at the 2007 IPC Archery World Championships

Any qualification slots earned in either the team or individual qualification methods at the 2007 IPC Archery World Championships and not used by the respective NPC will be reallocated to the NPC of the next highest ranked unqualified athlete(s) from this competition.

## Slots allocated to Host Country

Any qualification slots allocated to the Host Country that are not used will be reallocated through the IPC Outdoor Archery World Ranking Method to the NPC of the next highest ranked unqualified athlete from the respective sport class. If the next highest ranked athlete's score is below the MQS, the available qualification slot will be reallocated at the discretion of IPC Archery.

### Slots allocated from World Ranking

Any qualification slots earned from the IPC Outdoor Archery World Ranking Allocation Method that are not used by the respective NPC will be reallocated to the NPC of the next highest ranked unqualified athlete from the respective sport class. If the next highest ranked athlete's score is below the MQS, the



available qualification slot will be reallocated at the discretion of IPC Archery taking into account universality.

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
