ALLOCATION OF QUALIFICATION	The qualification is allocated to the individual athlete, not the NPC.
MAXIMUM QUOTA ALLOCATION PER NPC	An NPC may be allocated a maximum of three (3) qualification slots per individual event.
	 An NPC may be assigned a slot to compete in a maximum of five (5) men's team events with one (1) team per event and/or a maximum of three (3) women's team events with one (1) team per event.
	Each men's team event will be comprised of a minimum of six (6) and a maximum of sixteen (16) teams of at least two (2) qualified male athletes selected at the discretion of IPC Table Tennis.



MAXIMUM QUOTA ALLOCATION PER NPC (continued)	Each women's team event will be comprised of a minimum of six (6) and a maximum of twelve (12) teams of at least two (2) qualified female athletes selected at the discretion of IPC Table Tennis.
	IPC Table Tennis will confirm in writing to the NPCs the final competition formats for team events (ie, tournament sizes) no later than 25 April 2008.
ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY	To be eligible for selection by an NPC, athletes must be ranked on the IPC Table Tennis World Ranking List closing 31 December 2007, have to meet the requirements of the Tournament Credit System and have an IPC Table Tennis International Classification Card.
MAXIMUM ENTRY PER NPC	An NPC can enter a maximum of three (3) eligible athletes per individual event. An NPC can enter a maximum of one (1) eligible team per team event assigned, comprising a minimum of two (2) and a maximum of four (4) eligible athletes entered in individual events.

For those athletes competing in the same individual event under a different sport class, the qualification slot will be reallocated through the IPC Table Tennis Male and Female World Ranking Lists Allocation Method.	
	In the case that the 2007 IPC Table Tennis Regional Championships are not conducted or an event is not held at the 2007 IPC Table Tennis Regional Championships, the qualification slots attributed to the respective competition or specific event will be reallocated through the IPC Table Tennis Male and Female World Ranking Lists Allocation Method.

DATES / PROCESS OF CONFIRMATION OF QUALIFICATION SLOTS

By 4 April 2008, each NPC must confirm in writing (fax and e-mails are accepted) to IPC Table Tennis the number of qualification slots they will use. NPCs that have not replied by this date will have lost their qualification slots, and the IPC Table Tennis may reallocate these slots.

By 4 April 2008, relevant NPCs must confirm in writing (fax and e-mails are accepted) to IPC Table Tennis use of the qualification slots allocated through the Bipartite Commission Invitation method they will use. NPCs that have not replied by these dates will have lost their qualification slots, and IPC Table Tennis may reallocate these slots.



By 25 April 2008, IPC Table Tennis will confirm in writing the reallocation of all unused qualification slots.

By 26 April 2008, it is officially declared that the respective NPC's will use the allocated quota granted for the Beijing 2008 Paralympic Games. Any NPC that does not use some or all of the qualification slots allocated may be subject to sanctions by the IPC.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION SLOTS

Any qualification slots that are not used by the respective NPC will be reallocated as follows:

Slots allocated at the 2007 IPC Table Tennis Regional Championships

Any qualification slots earned in either the team or individual qualification methods at a 2007 IPC Table Tennis Regional Championships and not used by the respective NPC will be reallocated to the NPC of the next highest ranked unqualified athlete(s) from this competition.

Slots allocated through the IPC Table Tennis Male and Female World Ranking Lists Allocation Method

Any qualification slots that are not used by an NPC will be reallocated by the IPC Table Tennis to the next highest ranked unqualified athlete on the IPC Table Tennis Male and Female World Ranking Lists closing 31 December 2007.
