Allocation of Qualification Slots

The qualification slot is allocated to the NPC not to the individual athlete. In the case of a Bipartite Commission Invitation the qualification slot is allocated to the individual athlete not to the NPC

Maximum Quota Allocation per NPC

An NPC can be allocated no more than fourteen (14) male and seven (7) female athlete Individual qualification slots for a maximum quota allocation of twenty-one (21) qualification slots per NPC, with Tandem being counted as one (1) athlete. Exceptions may be granted through the Bipartite Commission Invitation Allocation method.

Athlete Eligibility

To be eligible for selection by an NPC, athletes (including Tandem pilots) must:

- hold a UCI license issued by a national cycling federation;
- be at least 18 years of age by 31 December 2020;
- must have raced in at least one (1) sanctioned, international UCI Para-Cycling competition between 1 January 2018 and 15 July 2020;
- be internationally classified with a 'Confirmed' sport class status or a 'Review' sport class status with a review date after 31 December 2020 (not applicable to Tandem pilots).



Maximum Entry per NPC

An NPC can enter a maximum of three (3) eligible athletes per Individual medal event. For the Individual Road Race medal events with combined sport classes an NPC can enter a maximum of three (3) eligible athletes per sport class and a maximum of five (5) eligible athletes per Individual Road Race medal event.

Each athlete must enter a minimum of two (2) medal events (Individual or Team).

An NPC can enter a maximum of one (1) team per Team medal event.

<p>2020 UCI Combined Nations Ranking Allocation</p>	<p>The factor used to calculate the number of male qualification slots allocated through the 2020 UCI Combined Nations Ranking Allocation method will be determined by adding the ranking points of all NPCs on the UCI Para-Cycling Combined Nations Ranking closing 7 June 2020, and then dividing the total by the number of available male qualification slots. Each NPC’s points will then be divided by this factor to calculate the number of male qualification slots for each NPC, up to a maximum of thirteen (13).</p> <p>The factor used to calculate the number of female qualification slots allocated through the 2020 UCI Combined Nations Ranking Allocation method will be determined by adding the ranking points of all NPCs on the UCI Para-Cycling Combined Nations Ranking closing 7 June 2020, and then dividing the total by the number of available female qualification slots. Each NPC’s points will then be divided by this factor to calculate the number of male qualification slots for each NPC, up to a maximum of six (6).</p> <p>UCI reserves the right to make minor adjustments to the factor in order to achieve the intended total allocation of male and female qualification slots. In most instances the allocation figure will be rounded up to the next whole number. However, at UCI’s discretion allocation figures with .40 or below may be rounded down.</p> <p>Furthermore, UCI will apply a “ring-fenced system” to some or all of an NPC’s allocated qualification slots in order to protect the viability of certain medal events. The NPC will be required to confirm entry of a qualified and eligible athlete in the specified sport class in order to retain the respective qualification slot.</p>	<p>100 male athletes 50 female athletes</p>
<p>Bipartite Commission Invitation Allocation</p>	<p>Five (5) eligible male athletes and five (5) eligible female athletes will be considered by the IPC and UCI for Bipartite Commission Invitation slots. TIMELINE

1 January 2018	Start of the period for athletes to achieve performances to be recorded on the UCI Para-Cycling Nations Ranking and the UCI Para-Cycling Combined Nations Ranking
31 December 2018	End of the period for athletes to achieve performances to be recorded on the UCI Para-Cycling Nations Ranking
8 May 2020	Deadline for Tokyo 2020 Organising Committee to receive accreditation application forms submitted by NPCs (“Accreditation Long List”)
7 June 2020	End of the period for athletes to achieve performances to be recorded on the UCI Para-Cycling Combined Nations Ranking
8 June 2020	Start of Bipartite Commission Invitation application process
15 June 2020	UCI notifies in writing to the NPCs the number of allocated qualification slots and ring-fenced positions from both Ranking Allocations
29 June 2020	Deadline for NPCs to confirm in writing to UCI the use of allocated qualification slots and ring-fenced positions
29 June 2020	Deadline for NPCs to submit Bipartite Commission Invitation applications to UCI
6 July 2020	UCI confirms in writing the reallocation of unused qualification slots and the awarding of Bipartite Commission Invitations
3 August 2020	Deadline for Tokyo 2020 Organising Committee to receive sport entry forms submitted by NPCs



CONFIRMATION PROCESS OF ALLOCATED SLOTS

By 29 June 2020 each qualified NPC must confirm to UCI in writing (only emails are accepted) the qualification slots they will use. NPCs that have not responded by this date will lose their qualification slots, and UCI may reallocate these slots.

By 6 July 2020 UCI will confirm in writing the reallocation of all unused qualification slots.

By 6 July 2020 it is officially declared that the respective NPCs will use the allocated quotas granted for the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games. Any NPC that does not use some or all of its allocated qualification slots may be subject to sanctions by IPC and UCI.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION SLOTS

Any qualification slots that are not used by an NPC will be reallocated via the Bipartite Invitation Commission Allocation method.


