Allocation of Qualification Slots

The qualification slot is allocated to the NPC not to the team or any individual athlete.

Maximum Quota Allocation per NPC

An NPC can be allocated no more than one (1) Men's team qualification slot and one (1) Women's team qualification slot.

Athlete Eligibility

To be eligible for selection by an NPC, athletes must:

- have played in at least one international, sanctioned World ParaVolley Sitting competition between 1 January 2018 and 31 March 2020; and
- be internationally classified with a 'Confirmed' sport class status or a 'Review' sport class status with a review date after 31 December 2020.

Maximum Entry per NPC

An NPC can enter a maximum of twelve (12) eligible male athletes for the Men's tournament and a maximum of twelve (12) eligible female athletes for the Women's tournament.

QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

Qualification slots will be allocated as follows:

CONFIRMATION PROCESS OF ALLOCATED SLOTS

By 31 March 2020 each qualified NPC must confirm to World ParaVolley in writing (email is accepted) if they wish to use their allocated slot(s). NPCs that have not responded by this date will lose their team qualification slots, and World ParaVolley will reallocate them.

By 14 April 2020 World ParaVolley will confirm in writing the reallocation of all unused team qualification slots.

By 14 April 2020 it is officially declared that the respective NPCs will use the allocated quota granted for the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games. Any NPC that does not use its allocated team qualification slot(s) may be subject to sanctions by IPC and World ParaVolley.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION SLOTS

Any team qualification slot(s) allocated and not used by the respective NPC will be reallocated, regardless of region, to the next highest ranked team(s), not otherwise qualified, on the World ParaVolley Ranking List as of 1 January 2020.
